- No sobriety requirement (depending on drug of abuse)
- Level 3.3 for three months, followed by level 3.1 for three months
- Capacity for 12 Women and 16 children
- A home environment supportive of clients' recovery
- Education on substance abuse, parenting, physical and mental health, and spiritual well-being
- OSSE Certified Child Development Center on-site

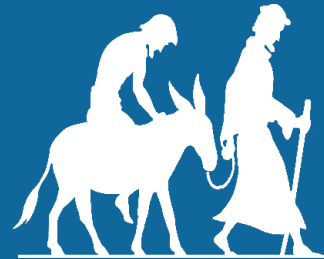

- Life skills such as effective communication, budgeting, time management, etc.
